Chester FC is a football club based at the Deva Stadium, Bumpers Lane. Chester FC play in the National League North, the sixth tier of football in England. The club was founded in 1885 when Chester Rovers merged with Old King's Scholars, changing its name to Chester City in 1983. The club has been fan-owned since 2010 when supporters group City Fans United formed a phoenix club from the ashes of the old club, which had been wound up due to serious financial problems. Under then manager Neil Young, Chester enjoyed great success between 2010 and 2013, winning three successive league titles and promotion to the National League, however the club was relegated in 2018. Chester have played at the Deva Stadium since 1992 having previously played at Sealand Road from 1906 until it was closed in 1990 when the club spent two years exiled in Macclesfield. The club's home colours are blue and white striped shirts, black shorts and blue socks. Chester's main rivals are Wrexham with the two clubs contesting the cross-border derby. The current managers of Chester FC are Anthony Johnson and Bernard Morley, who have been in charge since May 2018. The duo led the club to 9th place in 2018-19 and 6th place in 2019-20. The club's nicknames are The Blues, The Seals and City.
