GULP - GIVE UP LOVING POP

A health and wellbeing programme designed for primary school pupils to help them understand the impact of sugary drinks on their health and encourage healthier choices. It's a fun, educational initiative that aims to reduce children's consumption of sugary drinks by raising awareness and building healthier habits early on.

Key aims of GULP in primary schools:



EDUCATE

children on the health risks linked to high sugar intake (e.g., tooth decay, obesity).



EMPOWER

pupils with knowledge to make healthier drink choices.



ENCOURAGE

ge behavioural change nk in a supportive and engaging way



CHALLENGES

the class to give up sugary drinks through a 21-day pledge.

Includes a 45-minute classroom based workshop followed by a 45 minute practical session to reinforce learning through physical activity.

Designed for Year 3 & Year 4 pupils.

Delivered over a 4-week programme (Wk1: Introduction workshop, Wk2: Oral hygiene, Wk3: Sugar detectives, Wk4 Hydration).

Funded by Food Active and Cheshire West and Chester Council, allowing schools to access it free of charge.

CAREER ASSEMBLIES FOR PRIMARY SCHOO

Our Career Assemblies are an exciting and engaging way to introduce young learners in primary schools to the wide range of careers available in sport and football - both on and off the pitch.

Designed for Key Stage 2 pupils, these assemblies aim to inspire children by showing them how their passions, skills, and interests can lead to future opportunities within the sports industry and beyond.

What Do Our Career Assemblies Include?

- Interactive Presentations We explore the different roles at a football club from professional footballers to coaches, physiotherapists, media officers, groundskeepers, nutritionists, and more.
- Real-Life Examples We share stories and career journeys of people who work at Chester FC, helping pupils understand how they got into their roles and what their jobs involve.
- Skills and Aspirations Focus Pupils are encouraged to think about their own strengths, interests, and dreams, making links between school subjects and potential future careers.
- Q&A Sessions Pupils get the chance to ask questions and engage in discussions, helping build confidence and curiosity about the world of work.
- Careers in the Community We highlight how careers in sport can also have a positive impact on communities - like the work we do through coaching, health, and education programmes.

EXPLORE THE DEVA STADIUM

Step inside areas not usually open to the public, including the players' tunnel, changing rooms, dugouts, press area, and even the manager's office!



GO BEHIND THE

Discover what happens in the build-up to a match day - from kit preparation to media setup and team talks - helping pupils understand the teamwork and organisation that goes into running a football club.



LEARN ABOUT CLUB

Find out about the proud history of Chester FC and its role in the local community. Pupils will explore the club's journey. achievements, and values - giving them a deeper sense of local heritage and sporting culture.



INTERACTIVE AND **ENGAGING**

Tours are tailored to be age-appropriate and curriculum-linked, encouraging pupils to ask questions, think critically, and reflect on what they've learned.

Benefits for learners:

POST-16 FOOTBALL EDUCATION PROGRAMME

Inspiring the Next Generation Through Sport, Education & Community

At Chester FC Community Trust, we offer a range of bespoke programmes and enrichment opportunities for primary and secondary schools that can be tailored to meet the unique needs of your students. **What we offer:**

POSITIVE BEHAVIOUR WORKSHOPS

Aimed at Years 7-11, our workshops explore the impact of behaviour at football matches and in the wider community. Through classroom discussion and practical activities, we promote respect, responsibility, and positive decision-making.

What the workshop includes:

CLASSROOM-BASED DISCUSSION (45 MINS)

Students engage in open discussions about behavior at sports events and in communities, exploring real-life scenarios, sharing experiences, and learning the impact of positive and negative actions.

PRACTICAL SESSION (45 MINS)

The workshop includes an interactive sportbased activity that reinforces teamwork, respect, and communication through play.

CAREERS ASSEMBLIES AND WORKSHOPS

Engaging sessions introduce students to diverse careers in the football and sports industry, including coaching, media, physiotherapy, and groundskeeping.

- Includes real-life career journeys from Chester FC staff
- Highlights key skills and links between education and employment
- Encourages students to reflect on their own aspirations

We deliver high-quality football sessions for:

- Primary and secondary boys', girls', and mixed teams
